Kindly note **no proposal will be considered on Email or Hard Copy**, it should be through only Department Portal as per the mentioned **specified time/period. The Last date for submitting the proposal is 14-05-2022.** I also request you to submit requisite documents for funds already released to your organization for these events in the previous years.
